Developing learning power means working on four aspects of children's learning.

- **Resilience** – able to lock on to learning and to resist distractions either from outside or within
- **Resourcefulness** – able to draw on a wide range of learning methods and strategies
- **Reflectiveness** – to think profitably about learning and themselves as learners
- **Reciprocity** – making use of relationships in the most productive, enjoyable and responsible way
